PROTECT YOUR VENUE FROM FROM TERROR THREATS

- Locate tables and chairs so customers have clear visibility of the thoroughfare
- Are queues positioned in the direction of a potential vehicle attack route?
- Avoid customers standing for lengthy periods against a building
- Put up bollards and security barriers to protect outdoor seating areas
- Use inconspicuous barriers such as water features or planters to act as hostile vehicle mitigation barriers

- Take care when hiring new employees, observing best practice and usual HR processes
- Be vigilant about sharing sensitive information to employees
- Make all on-site staff aware of your security procedures
- Improve your security measures including increased security presence, door staff and CCTV
